



44 cars ready on the grid of 2023 Italian F.4 Championship
The final number still set to increase before the season start at Imola, up to a maximum of 48 entries in the Championship

Monday, March 6th, 2023 – The **Italian F.4 Championship promoted by ACI Sport and WSK Promotion** promises another ground breaking season, ready to top the record numbers of the latest edition.

The Italian Formula 4 Championship established great legacy over the years, becoming the main reference in the international scene of F4 series.
