# REGULARITY ALPINE CHALLENGE

- Prologue on day one with five Special Stages, and the Rally over two days with 15 Special Stages
- Supplementary Regulations pertaining to the Alpine Challenge Regularity Rally

#### TOURISM

- Rally over two days, open to classic cars (those over 30 years old) and GT Sports categories.
- Historic route, with Road Book with road direction diagrams (herringbone) comprising several sectors of simple navigation.
- Supplementary Regulations pertaining to the Tourism/GT Alpine Challenge.

# /EHICLES ELIGIBLE TO TAKE PART

#### IA KEGULAKITY

- Cars from the periods B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J1 and J2 without division of classes, with current registration and valid insurance
- A 2kg fire extinguisher [within date of expiry]
- Mandatory licence (a temporary licence may be considered).

# REGULARITY ALPINE CHALLENGE

- All classic cars over 30 years old, having a current licence and insurance, and first registered on or before 31 December 1990
- Youngtimers, 25 years or over, may be included with the special permission of the organiser.
- (Cars registered between 1.1.1991 and 31.12.1995)
- JURISM

A licence is not needed.

- All classic cars over 30 years old, with a current licence and insurance, and first registered on or before 31 December 1990
- "loungtimers', 25 years or over, may be included with special permission from the organiser. Fore registered between 1 1 1001 and 21 19 1005
- [Cars registered between 1.1.1991 and 31.12.1995].

Sport GT cars (coupé 2-door, 2 seaters or 2 + 2)

A licence is not needed

The organiser reserves the right to accept one or more vehicles which do not fit these criteria but which would contribute something of particular interest to this event.

# LUDITATION Registration will close on Monday 21 September 2020

For the 3-day event: the full amount for 1 team comprising 2 people and 1 vehicle, from the Friday morning to the Sunday afternoon will be :

Supplementary nights (Ihursday) with any extra meals outside the package offered are the responsibility of the participants and must be settled privately.

The organiser reserves the right to refuse an application without having to give an explanation. In this event, the documents and registration forms will be returned to those who are refused admission.
